The Ontario Police College, in cooperation with the Ontario Association of Police Educators (OAPE), is pleased to offer the Reid Investigative Interviewing Course for Child Abuse Investigators in both the policing and social work fields. This joint training event is being hosted at the Canadian Centre for Inland Waters at 867 Lakeshore Road, Burlington (free parking available).

The three day course runs from September 28 to 30, 2010 and the daily sessions start at 0800 hours and conclude at 1600 hours. On-site registration will take place on September 28th from 0700 to 0745 hours with the training starting promptly at 0800 hours.

Police officers and child protection workers who conduct interviews in instances where child abuse is suspected will find this training valuable. Joint training was first offered in 2007 and feedback around the practical application for this material was very positive. Registration is limited to 200 participants due to the certification process (100 police officers and 100 child protection workers).


The three days are comprised of the Reid Investigative Interviewing Course for Child Abuse Investigators presented by David M. Buckley, author of *How to Identify, Interview and Interrogate Child Abuse Offenders*. A certificate will be issued at the conclusion of the training.

Refreshments will be served for morning and afternoon breaks but the participants will be responsible for their own lunch. There is a cafeteria on site which can be utilized by the participants. Those wishing to stay near the training site are responsible for making their own accommodation arrangements. The Travel Lodge Hotel, Burlington, 2020 Lakeshore Road, Burlington, 905-681-0762 has set aside a block of rooms at the rate of \$99.00 per night, plus tax, double occupancy, under "Reid Training".

The registration form is attached for your convenience. The cost for this training is \$550 + GST per person (\$577.50 total cost). Payment by cheque or money order should be made out to OAPE and is required with the registration form. The registration form and payment should be sent to the Office of the Registrar at the Ontario Police College.
